  - Title Page: The full name of the candidate.

All to be selected by the candidate. A very short description with the dimensions of the work and media can accompany each slide.
  - Up to 10 images from selected pages out of ongoing notebooks, sketchbooks and visual journals.

### *Drama Applicants only*

- A separate sheet listing your previous dramatic achievements: productions, qualifications, dramatic groups and societies with the candidate's name and date of birth at the top
- Prepare two contrasting monologues (one may be musical theatre) to perform at our Scholarship Day
- Prepare a portfolio of programmes, photos or certificates to bring to assessment
